

Art Exhibition Registration

Complete one form per entry.

- There is a separate form for Members', Men's Corner, and Children's Corner entries.
- Entry forms are available on TTWC's website. Extra forms are available upon request in The Club office as of January 2018.
- The forms will also be attached to Art Show articles in The Tuckahoe Flyer. Registration: Monday, January 29, 2018, through Friday, February 23, 2018. No changes accepted after Friday, March 9, 2018.

Art Sale to Benefit The Scholarship Endowment Fund

Participating artists will be given the opportunity to sell their original works. A minimum of twenty-five percent (25%) of each sale will go to benefit The Scholarship Endowment Fund. This opportunity is extended to all Exhibit categories. An art item donated by a member will be offered for the annual raffle with 100% of the proceeds benefiting The Scholarship Endowment Fund.

Art Exhibition and Sale Rules

THESE RULES MUST BE STRICTLY FOLLOWED IN ALL CATEGORIES BY EVERY EXHIBITOR.

- A maximum of three (3) entries per category is permitted with the exception of Children's Corner, where the maximum number of entries is limited to two (2).
- Works **may not** have been previously exhibited at The Tuckahoe. All entries must have been completed in the last five (5) years with the exception of needlework entries.
- All works must show exhibitor's name and title of work on the back.
- Member exhibitors have the option to have their work judged and/or purchased. Each registration form should be marked accordingly.
- The Judge is granted the privilege to award as many ribbons as deemed worthy. Ribbon color (blue, red, or white) is acknowledgement of the level of achievement as determined by the Judge.
- One (1) tricolor ribbon will be awarded to the "Best in Show" for each category.
- One (1) gold ribbon will be awarded for the best "Original Design" in Needlework and one for the "Most Creative" in Creative Arts.

IN ADDITION TO THE GUIDELINES LISTED ABOVE, PLEASE ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS SPECIFIC TO EACH CATEGORY.

Painting Exhibit

Paintings submitted in this category may include oil, acrylic, watercolor, pastels, mixed medium, silk screen, collage, and sketching.

Original source material - plein air paintings done on site and/or finished from artist's own or other amateur photography only.

Please contact the Painting Coordinator before submitting your registration form if you have questions on this matter.

Paintings must be framed or gallery wrapped (staples do not show on the sides) and ready for hanging to include: eye hooks or screws attached to frames with wire on the back. (Paintings that are not correctly framed and wired will not be accepted.

Clip-on frames are not acceptable.)

Paintings over 3X4 feet (including frames) will be accepted on a space available basis.

Paintings done from the following are not acceptable: any copyrighted photos or photos taken by a professional (a person who received compensation for photographic works) as well as any travel posters/brochures, postcards, books, magazines, newspapers, or downloaded internet photos. Even if you have a professional's permission to use the images, this is not completely your original work and it cannot be entered into the show. Copying from other artists' paintings is not acceptable. Work must be original and by a Tuckahoe Woman's Club member.

Photography Exhibit

Work must be original and photographed by a Tuckahoe Woman's Club member. All methods of photography (digital and film) are acceptable.

Photographs must be framed in wooden or metal frames or canvas wrapped and ready for hanging to include eye hooks or screws attached to frames with wire on the back. (Photographs that are not correctly framed and wired will not be accepted.) Photographs may be printed on metal or aluminum but should be made ready for hanging.

No plastic frames, plastic string brackets, or clip-on frames will be accepted.

All framed photographs must be matted.

"Series" photographs must be grouped in ONE frame and matted. Multiple framed photographs will not be accepted as a "single" entry.

For the best showing, you are encouraged to enter photographs no smaller than 8X10 inches.

Needlework Exhibit

Entries must be done by a Tuckahoe Woman's Club member and may include fine hand or machine sewing, smocking, quilting, embroidery, canvas work, crocheting, knitting, etc.

All needlework must be completed and blocked for exhibiting.

Entries must strictly adhere to a maximum of three (3) items with the following clarification: an entry that has multiple parts, such as a pair of pillowcases, will be counted as one entry.

Please contact the Needlework Coordinator before submitting your registration form if you have questions on this matter.

Creative Arts Exhibit

Entries must be done by a Tuckahoe Woman's Club member and may include fine quality, handmade items such as sculpture, ceramics, Christmas decorations, dolls, hand painted articles, jewelry, miniatures, porcelain, pottery, weaving, woodworking, scrap booking, "trash to treasure" items, etc.

All entries must be original, i.e., no copies of any original works or prints or reproductions, such as prints of paintings or photographs.

Entries must strictly adhere to a maximum of three (3) items with the exception of any entry that is clearly a “set,” such as a set of stem ware. Please contact the Creative Arts Coordinator before submitting your registration form if you have questions on this matter.

Men’s Corner Exhibit

Husbands of members are invited to exhibit original paintings, photography, carving, handcrafts, jewelry, needlework, “trash to treasure” items, woodcraft, etc.

Entries will not be judged; paintings and photography only may receive a written critique by the judge if requested on the entry form.

Children’s Corner Exhibit

Children and grandchildren of members ages 5 through 18 are invited to exhibit original paintings, photography, carvings, handcrafts, jewelry, needlework, “trash to treasure” items, woodcraft, etc. Entries will be judged.
